## **Confirmed:**

- We have been awarded the Grant from Calne Area Board and can go ahead with all the previously agreed arrangements. This award includes money for the Fairtrade Town banners if Calne is approved – if not, we will return the relevant amount.
- A1 posters on order from JAM Prints who have matched priced a quote from Corsham Print. A3
  posters printed at Church House. A4 & A5 posters being printed by Stan. [Done]
- The projection screen is on order at a cheaper cost of £22 (now received)
- Bunting and Balloons Caroline has bunting at the Methodist church, will need some strong cord for this and buy some pumps. (Action: Stan)
- Stan confirmed the library and Harris room is booked at a combined cost of £68 David informed.
- Calne Players are booked for a short sketch.
- Barber shop cannot come. Possibility of singers through Caroline contact. Action: Caroline [afternote: unfortunately declined as have a previous engagement, but keen to be at a future event.]
- Colouring ACTIVITY sheets available for children, agreed to give out small Fairtrade chocolates with these, no prizes, need a table for this. Print outs and felt tips to be purchased. (Action: Jenny W)
- Cake competition not many entrants so far, at least 5 entrants needed for each age category so need to publicise more Facebook, Shout out Calne, Sally Fox at Hilmarton, poster to go in Launderette, Town Hall, W.I. Christians in Calne, BBC Wiltshire radio. (Action: ALL)
