Section A – Previous Meeting's Business

First of all Stan welcomed Joanne from the Co-op to the meeting. Then we went round the table introducing each other to Joanne.

1. Minutes of last meeting (8th September 2017) (acceptance). The minutes were agreed and duly signed by the chair.

2. Matters Arising.

- Letters to school, letters sent to the primary schools by Stan. Just gone. St. Mary's to be done as soon as possible. FTF has some FT schools things designed for special needs so Springfields need a special letter. Also need to write to St. Margaret's.
- Calne area board resolution wording regarding serving FT tea and coffee, Stan has written to them but no response yet – needs chasing. David will speak to Jane Vaughan about it. Stan will ask Tom Rounds to ask at the meeting.
- FT audit sharing out the tasks this will be done late in the meeting.
- Stan spoke to the guides who would not divulge the leader's contact details, Stan gave them his details but he has not heard back yet.
- Fashion show research not yet been done. Penny will research this.

- Grant application awarded £880 from the Calne Area Board now in our account. Mainly for advertising, banners, etc.
- Grant application Town Hall costs awarded for FTF event on Sat 3rd March £280. They don't give us the money, they wrote to say venue is confirmed and paid for.
- Section 106 money not possible to use this for our purposes of educational prizes. It has to be site specific in the locality of the development. Our use is too broad for this type of funding.
 Need to look elsewhere.
- Stan asked Joanne if the Coop do small packs of FT chocolate to give away in town when promoting the campaign during the lantern parade, Sat 2nd Dec. Joanne will check what is available. She will contact Stan by email.
- Policy and procedure to be dealt with later.
- Stan reported that the Website has been updated and altered; the deep header has been altered to a thin bright header along the top.
- Policies and Procedures

Health and Safety policy – drafted – will circulate.

Child protection/safeguarding – drafted. How will our work in schools be affected by this? Will we need DBS? Where we work with schools there would be a teacher present. Need to take advice on this.

Equal opportunity policy – drafted.

Public Liability Policy – not started – perhaps include some words in the constitution cover this.

May be more cost effective to buy PL insurance as one off per event. This was done for last years FTF event through the FT foundation.

Should check if all our stall holders have public liability cover at any event that we run.

Check the small print of our public liability policies to see if they are covered by ours or need our own. Stan will check this. Then include in our constitution.

PL and Employers Insurance for volunteers – requirements for volunteers? Needs looking into.
